ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS
TO ASEACCU

The Association of Southeast and East Asian Catholic Colleges and Universities (**ASEACCU**) is a regional association of Catholic colleges and universities in countries within this geographical area. The main goals of the organization are to promote Catholic higher education, to contribute to the educational dialog on an international level beyond the Southeast and East Asian region, and to provide support for the local Churches.

Any Catholic college or university that is legally constituted and shows an institutional commitment to the values and goals of ASEACCU may apply to become a member. Applications for new members are accepted on an ongoing basis throughout distinct phases. To promote consistency and high standards, universities and colleges are required to meet specific requirements to become members of ASEACCU. As such, in accordance with ASEACCU's bylaw and current procedure in place, acceptance of an institution to ASEACCU membership requires:

- Candidate to be an institution in the Southeast or East Asian Region that are recognized legal degree-granting Catholic universities and colleges in their respective country or National Associations of Catholic universities and colleges within the Southeast and East Asian Region;
- Candidate must be nominated by two current member institutions of ASEACCU in good standing¹;
- 3. Institutional commitment to the implementation of the "Ex Corde Ecclesiae";
- **4.** Candidate to provide general and background information, and student enrollment figures of the institution²;
- **5.** Candidate to provide a motivation letter.

^{1 -} Members in good standing should not been absent from more than two consecutive Annual Meetings and General Assemblies; nor be remiss in paying their annual dues for more than two consecutive years.

- **6.** Submission of the required documents and information to the ASEACCU Secretariat;
- **7.** Candidate's application to be reviewed and recommended by the ASEACCU Executive Board;
- **8.** Candidate's application is to be approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of the ASEACCU present in a General Assembly.
